BLACK PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT

On 02/17/15 the Keller City Council approved a zoning request change from Planned Development - Single Family - Residential - Low Density (36,000 SF minimum) to Planned Development Single Family- Residential (25,000 SF minimum) for 37.61 acres of the Black property located next to Williamsburg Estates. The Planned Development aspect of this project was done at the behest of the City Council to give the City greater leverage in ensuring that the development would proceed as verbally described earlier by the developer/builder. This request did not include any portion of commercial zoning. A request for commercial zoning for a portion of the property may be presented at a later date. Garlic will be stronger the longer you marinade.

Don't be afraid of the garlic it makes the steak taste wonderful!

Either grill the steaks or pan fry them in butter.

Either way they're great!

I do both; I grill them until they're almost done then finish the cooking by pan frying.
