Neighborhood News

BLACK PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT. On Monday, March 9, 2015, the Keller Planning & Zoning Commission recommended

- a change to a 2.35-acre portion of a tract of land from PD-SF-25 (Planned Development-Single Family Residential-25,000 square foot minimum) to PD-C (Planned Development-Commercial) for two sit-down restaurants.
- a revision to the residential lots accordingly on the adjacent 35.09 acres portion of the tract of land zoned PD-SF-25 (Planned Development-Single Family Residential-25,000 square foot minimum).

The owner / developer, M/I Homes of Dallas, will come back at a later date with the site plan for the planned restaurant. The zoning changes will be going to the Keller City Council for final review and approval on Tues., 3/17.

Clarification is being sought about a condition that the City Council had put on the developer for City Council approval. The 2/17/15 re-zoning was approved with two exits to Rufe Snow and no future exits to the east (e.g., into Williamsburg). On 3/9/15 the developer changed the plan to having only one exit onto Rufe Snow. A variance supposedly is included to prevent future access into Williamsburg. **Upon reading the proposed variance, it does not provide any wording to protect our neighborhood from being a point of future access.** Come to the City Council meeting on Tues., 3/17 at 7:00 PM, Keller Town Hall to voice your position.

INCREASED POLICE PATROLS FOR SPEEDING. The City of Keller Police is increasing patrol coverage for **Williamsburg, the Keys of Keller and Danbury Parks** to monitor speeding. This is due to complaints about go-carts and residents' requests for a traffic study. **The speed limit is 20 mph through these neighborhoods** since they have grandfathered speed limits. Newer neighborhoods have a speed limit of 25 mph. We've been told the police will typically give citations for car going 8 mph above the 20 mph speed limit.

TRAFFIC STUDY. The City of Keller wants to get updated traffic counts in Williamsburg since Rufe Snow has been completed. They want to see if there has been any change in the volume through the neighborhood since the last study was made in 2012. You may see the city's black tubes in the street to count traffic.

NEIGHBORHOOD DIRECTORY. Residents will be receiving an email on Wed., March 18th about the Williamsburg Neighbor Directory. The directory will be password-protected on the WilliamsburgofKeller.com website. The password is being shared only with Williamsburg residents and will change yearly (unless a reason comes up to change it sooner). The directory will not be accessible to the public or to internet search engines.

The benefits of the on-line directory include

- Easier to have the latest information
- Easier and quicker to submit updates
- Easier and quicker for the Board to maintain.

Residents can access directory information in a variety of ways:

- Last name
- Street listing
- All residents by last name
- All residents by street listing

The information can be viewed or printed since the information is stored as PDF files.

For those residents who requested that their information not be published in the directory, “Not Listed” is shown. Changes to resident’s information can be submitted online any time and will typically be made within a 2 to 3 days.

As an extension of the Neighborhood Directory, we will have a **Neighborhood Services** section that will allow young residents (and those young-at-heart) to list their availability to provide neighborhood services such as babysitting, pet sitting, lawn/yard work. This listing will be available only to Williamsburg residents via the password access.

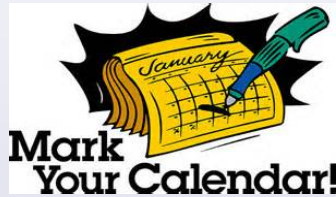

City Council Approves Keller's First Noise Ordinance

2/17/2015

The new ordinance applies to noises and their vibrations created by both residents and businesses, and essentially works in three layers: a 24/7 standard for “unreasonable noise,” enhanced standards at night in and adjacent to residential areas, and a curfew for outdoor music played in commercial zones (regardless of whether complaints have been voiced).

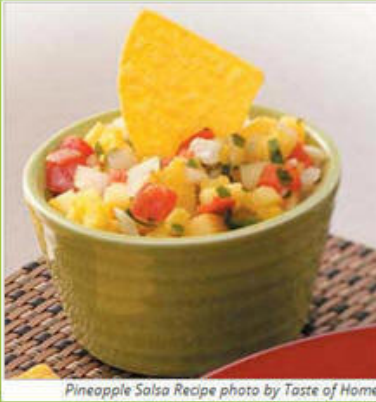


Enhanced standards in and adjacent to residential areas, which prohibit sound created by loudspeakers, PA systems, amps, yelling/shouting, barking dogs, lawn equipment (mowers, blowers) and similar, run from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

What's Cooking in the 'Burg?

PINEAPPLE SALSA

This mouthwatering salsa shared by Suzi LaPar of Wahiawa, Hawaii features fresh pineapple and a handful of seasonings. Serve it with tortilla chips or atop grilled chicken or fish for a jazzed-up meal.

14 servings

INGREDIENTS

2 cups diced fresh pineapple
2 medium tomatoes, seeded and chopped
3/4 cup chopped sweet onion
1/4 cup minced fresh cilantro
1 jalapeno pepper, seeded and chopped
1 tablespoon olive oil
1 teaspoon ground coriander
3/4 teaspoon ground cumin
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon minced garlic

Tortilla chips

DIRECTIONS

In a large bowl, combine the first 10 ingredients. Cover and refrigerate until serving. Serve with tortilla chips. Yield: 3-1/2 cups.

Editor's Note: Wear disposable gloves when cutting hot peppers; the oils can burn skin. Avoid touching your face.
